**Chapter 2.6 COMMON RADIO PROCEDURE WORDS**

ProWord      Meaning

Acknowledge      Receipt of this message must be acknowledged by the addressee.

All After      I refer to the part of the message after...

All Before      I refer to the part of the message before...

All Stations      I am calling all stations on this net.

Break      A formal stoppage of a message. Can be used to pre-empt traffic for a higher priority message, or to end a formal message or message segment.

Check      “Correct”.

Correct      Your information (or version of a message) is correct.

Correction      An error has been made in this transmission. Transmission will continue with the last word correctly transmitted.

Discard      This transmission was made in error - discard it.

Figures      The following numbers will be transmitted as individual digits using phonetic number (Derived from the “figures” key on radio teletypes).

From      The message originated from...

How Copy (So Far)?      Did you copy my message (or the part that just ended)?

I say Again      I am repeating the transmission or the portion indicated. (“Repeat” is not a ProWord).

I Spell      The next word will be spelled after it is pronounced.

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**Chapter 2.6 Rev A COMMON RADIO PROCEDURE WORDS**

Wait I must pause for a few seconds; do not transmit.

Wait Out I must pause for a longer than a few seconds; do not transmit.

Wilco I have received and will comply with your message. Never used with “Roger”.

Word After I refer to the word after...

Word Before I refer to the word before...

Words Twice I will send each phrase (or word) twice due to difficult conditions.

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
